

**Introduction**: After World War I, the Czechs and Slovaks of the former Austro-Hungarian Empire merged to form Czechoslovakia, but then split in 1993 in the nonviolent "velvet divorce." The Czech Republic joined NATO in 1999 and the EU in 2004. The country added the short-form name Czechia in 2016.

**Cultural Practices:** Czech people value direct communication, friendliness, and modesty. It's polite to say Dobrý den (Good day) or Na shledanou (Goodbye) respectively.

**Tipping Guidelines:** It is acceptable to tip 10-15% at a restaurant if no service charge is included. Tip bellhops \$1 (USD) per bag for carrying luggage to your room; leaving a small tip for housekeeping is appreciated. Tipping is not required for taxi drivers.

**Climate**: A temperate continental climate with cold winters and warm summers. The weather is generally mild, with snow in the mountains during winter and moderate rain throughout the year.

**Religion:** Roman Catholic 7%, other believers belonging to a church or religious society 6% (includes Evangelical United Brethren Church and Czechoslovak Hussite Church), believers unaffiliated with a religious society 9.1%, none 47.8%, unspecified 30.1%
